The eager children cry.

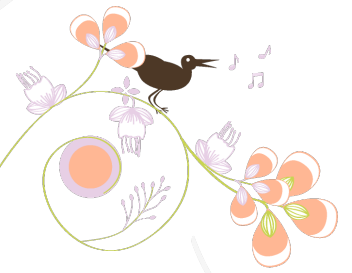
Why, Mary loves the lamb, you know,

Mama's going to buy you a looking glass.

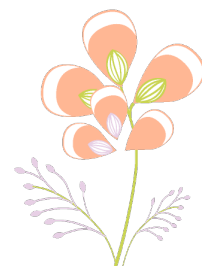
If that looking glass gets broke,

# I Measure Myself

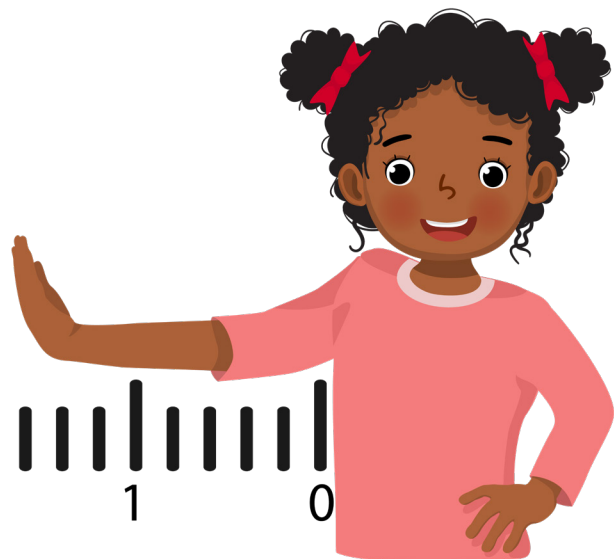


I measure myself
