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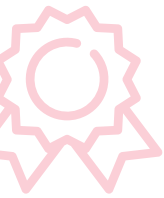

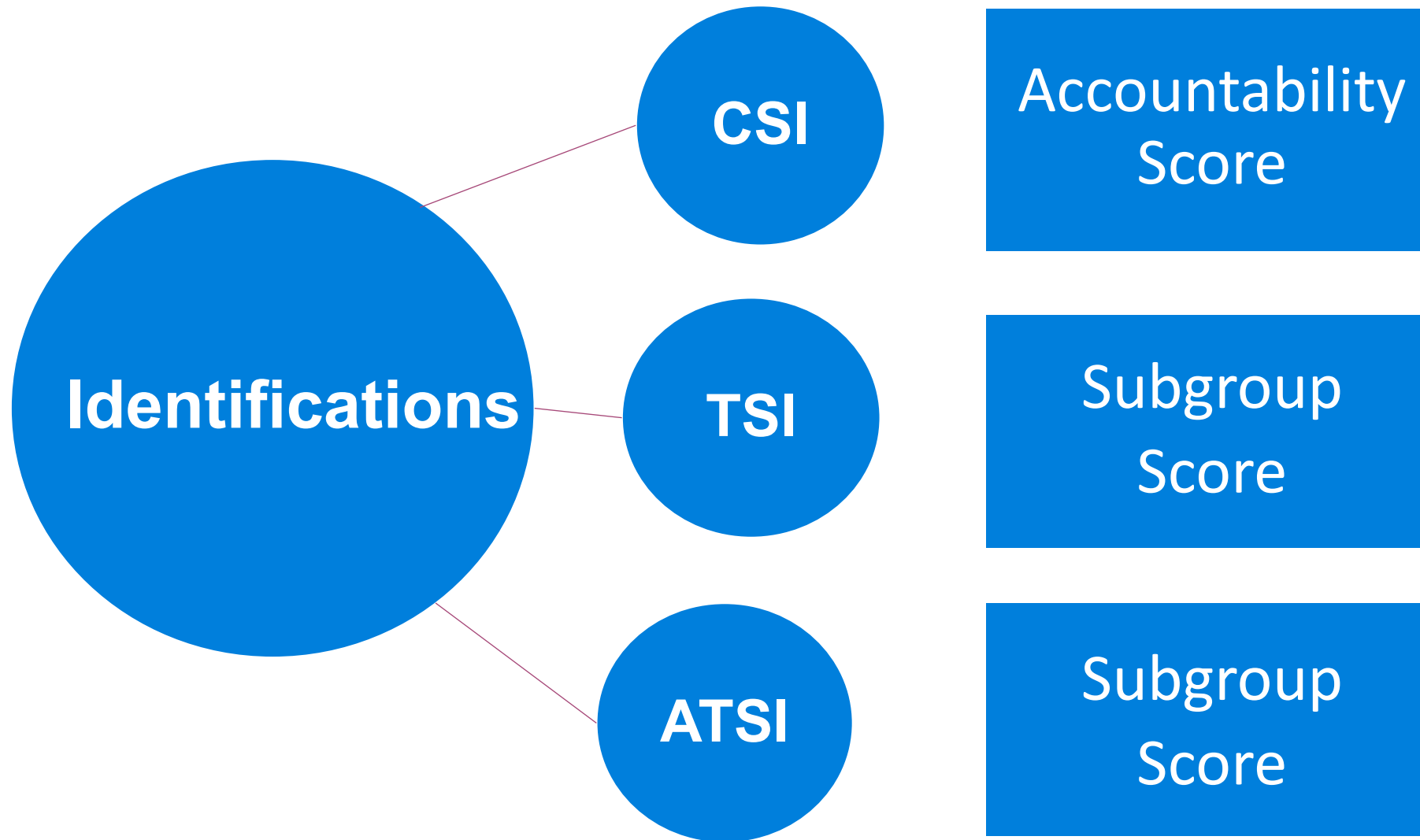

  - contains information for each identified school (CSI, TSI, and ATSI)
- **CSI Spreadsheet**
  - Contains CSI summary data for identification and exit
- **TSI Ranking and Exiting Data**
  - Contains information about each school/subgroup and the criteria for TSI identification and Exit
- **District Detail Data**
  - Specific to individual districts – Contains data for subgroups (2018-19, 2021-22, and 2022-2023)

- Ensure that the documentation collected is filed and in a location that can be accessed regardless of whether there is a personnel change.





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
