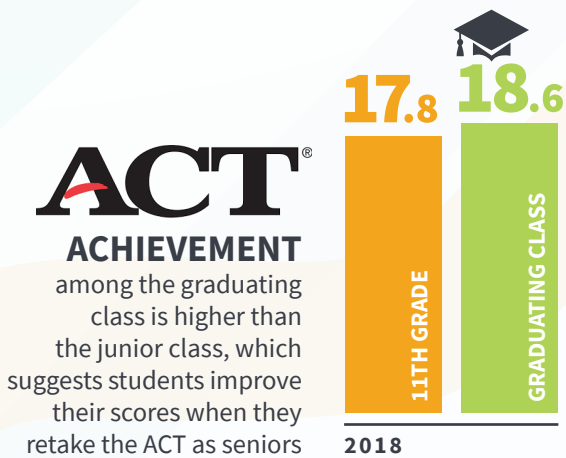
SCHOLAR AWARDS NEARLY DOUBLE

expand from one in 2015 to five early college high schools and one middle college program in 2018

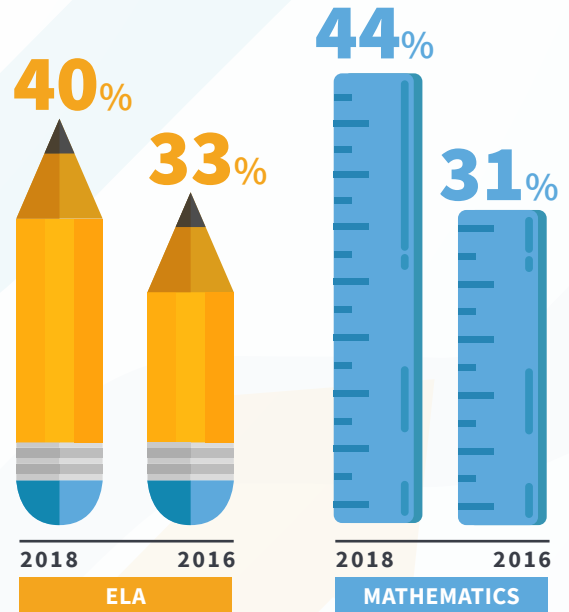

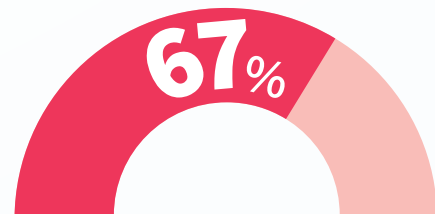
