Blooket is a new fun tool to use for review games and trivia. Teachers can choose the type of game and question sets. Games can be played live or used as enrichment. A code is generated, and students can join on any device they choose.

CLASSROOM CONNECTIONS

[4Cs: Collaboration, Communication, Creativity, Critical Thinking]

Blooket is a gamification tool that allows creative formative assessments or group review that can be used in groups or for solo study to create student agency. Host a live game in which students can compete in the classroom. Homework is an asynchronous game students can use during their free time. Five of the twelve game modes can be assigned as homework. Game sets can be found in the Discovery area, imported from your Quizlet, or you can create your own. Teachers receive feedback on what the students get correct and incorrect to drive instruction in the classroom.

Collaboration Students can work in teams like trivia night to decide on answers.

Critical Thinking Game options have underlying skills that can be sharpened in speed, insight, strategy, accuracy and focus.

Choose a question set or create a new set. Select a game mode from 12 choices and set time or point limits. Host or join the Blooket set live in class or on your own device. Afterwards analyze results with a detailed report to see how and what your students are learning.
