

Tip #1 - The Google Timer

The basic time saving shortcuts -

Ctrl + C and Ctrl + X

Ctrl + C will copy the highlighted text or selected item. Ctrl + X will cut them.

Ctrl + V


Ctrl + V will paste the text or object that's in the clipboard.

Ctrl + Z and Ctrl + Y

Undo(Z) or Redo(Y) any change.

Ctrl + F

Pressing Ctrl + F opens the Find in any program.



*On a Mac,
replace **Ctrl** with
Command

The Ultimate “Ctrl” shortcut.

Ctrl + Shift+ T - Opens a closed tab.

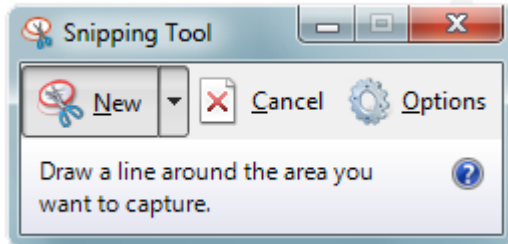


If Browser is closed accidentally, it will also restore all tabs prior to closing.



Screen caps and Snipping

Need a selection of text AND pictures?



Snipping tool or Screen
can get that for you.

Windows snipping tool lets you draw a box around any part of your screen, and save it as an image.

*In Windows 10 you can use the keyboard shortcut
(WinKey+Shift+S)

*On a Mac - **Command+shift+4** does the same thing.

Snipping Content from anywhere!

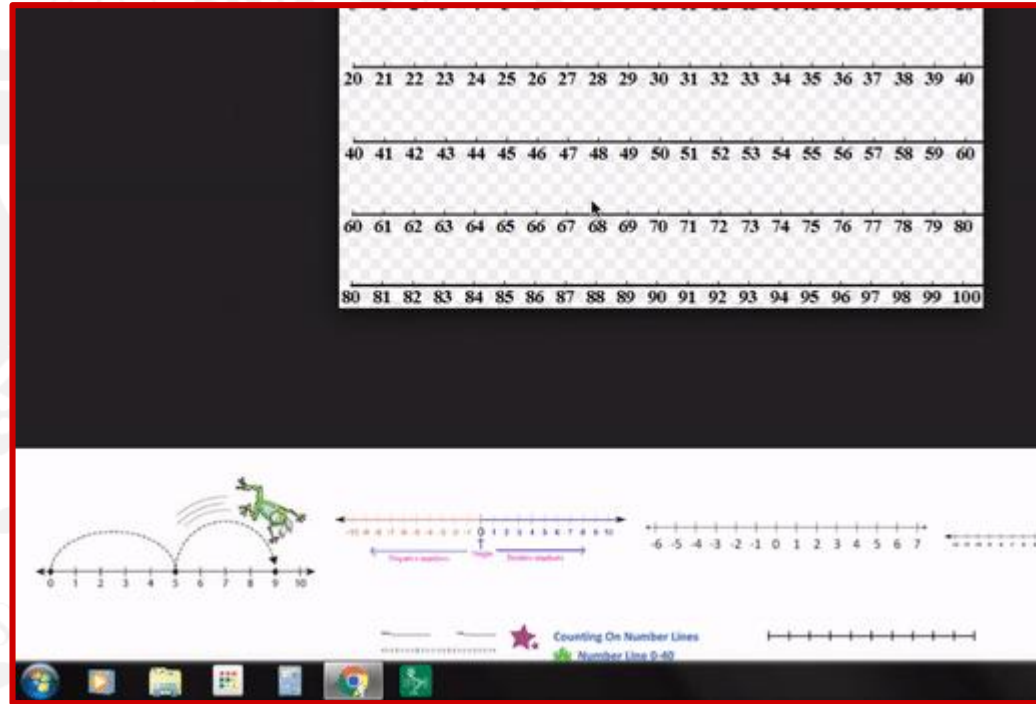
Using the Windows Snipping tool is easy! - (Windows 7 computers and up)

Click on the Window button and type "Snip."

Open the Snipping Tool.

Draw a box around what you want.

Copy it to use now, or save it to use in the future.



How to Take a Screenshot on a Chromebook

Let's say you need to take a snap of your entire screen. To do this you press the 'Ctrl' and 'Window Switcher' keys at the same time:



If you just want to capture a specific area of the screen just add shift to the key combo, like so:

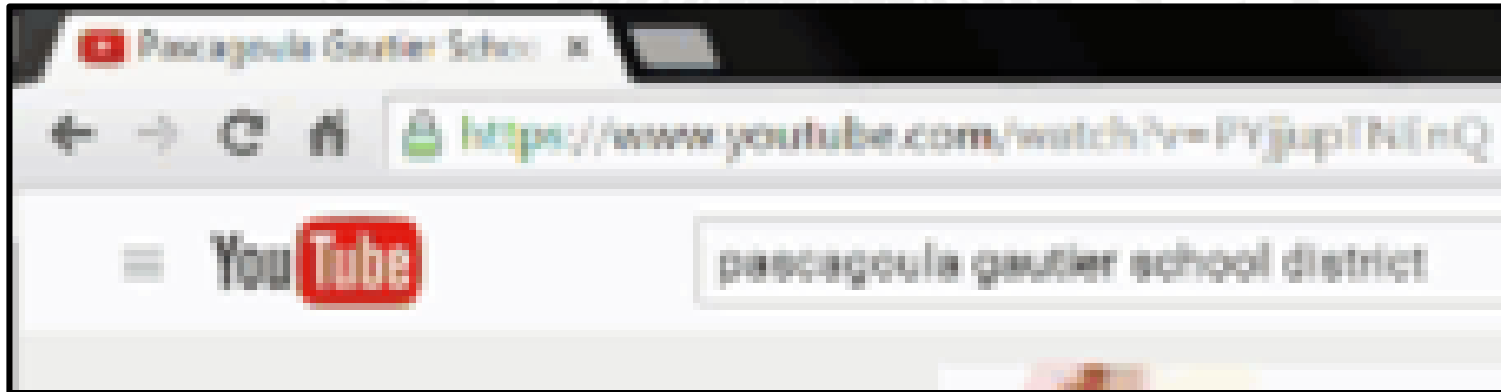

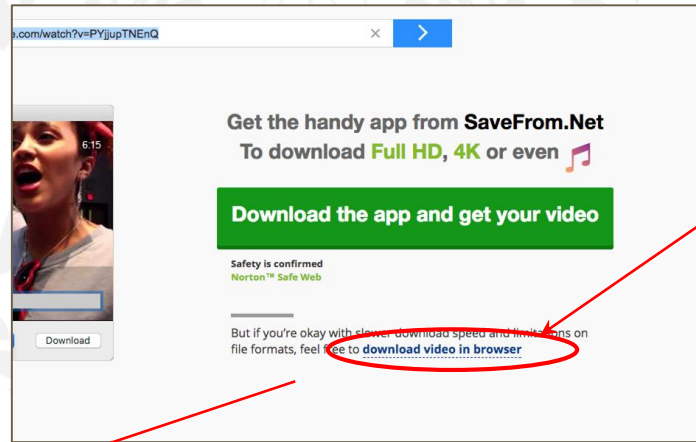
Saving Videos from YouTube

This one is easy... Find the video you want, and type "ss" between the "www." and the "youtube" in the address.

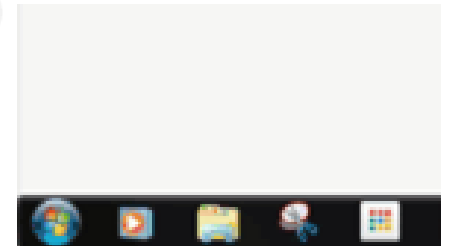


Saving Videos from YouTube

It takes you to savefrom.net and generates a download link. Click "Download," and just close out the pop-up box that appears.

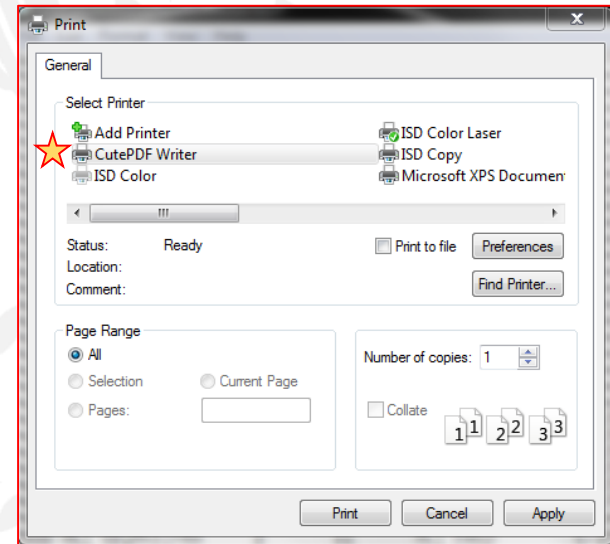
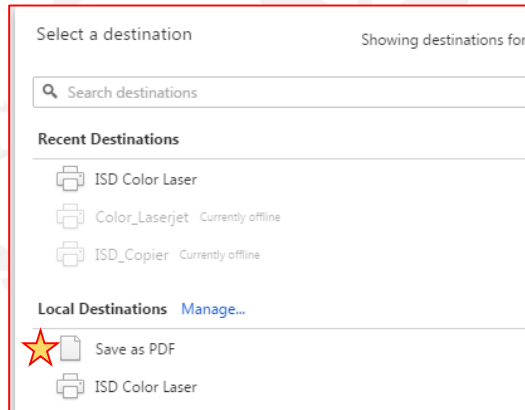
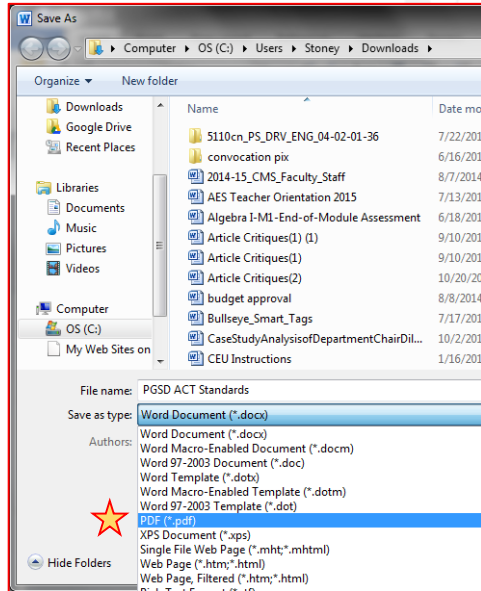


Your video will download into your downloads folder.



Saving Documents as a PDF

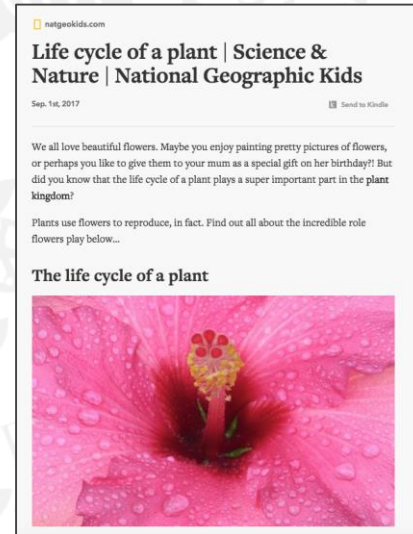
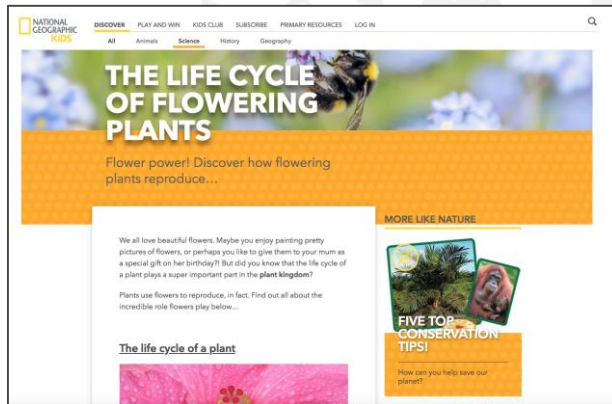
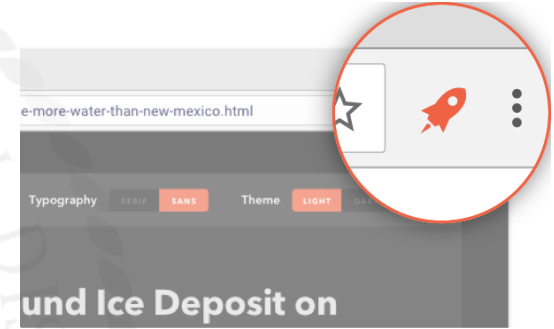
In most cases, you can simply select "Save As" and choose "PDF."
Occasionally though, you'll need to select "Print" and choose Save as PDF or CutePDF Writer

Click the 3 dots in the top right of the navigation bar.



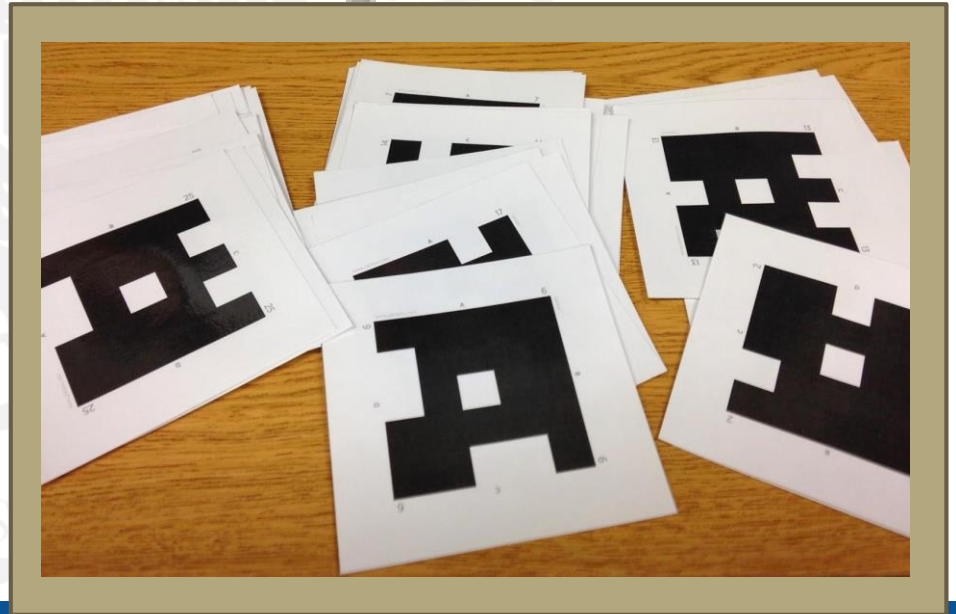

What is a Kahoot?

A Kahoot is a learning game created on the Kahoot! platform, which consists of multiple choice questions - as a quiz, discussion or survey - in any topic, language or ability. It's projected at the front of the classroom, & played by the whole class together in real-time (answering on their own personal device)



How to get started-

4.ADD A COVER IMAGE(optional)

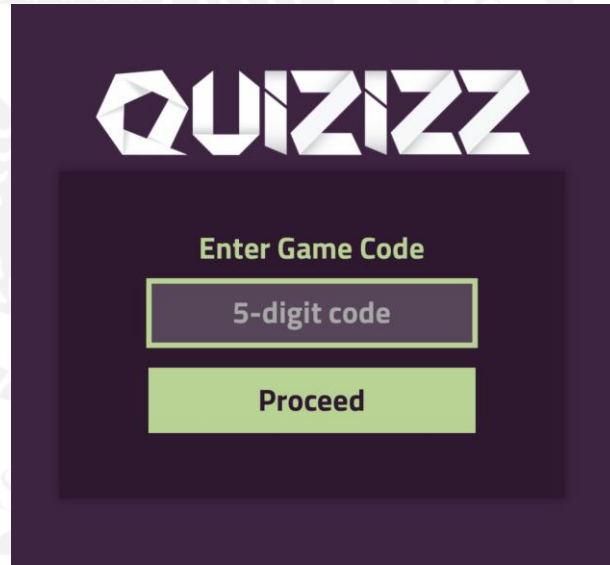

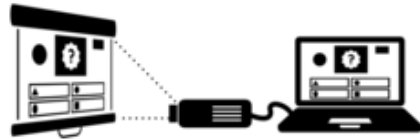


What's the difference?

Kahoot!

HOST

The host's computer is used to display questions.



PLAYERS

Players' devices only show clickable buttons.



QUIZIZZ

HOST

The host's computer is used to monitor realtime results.



PLAYERS

Players' devices show questions and clickable answer options.





General Tips

Seek Help



Don't be afraid to ASK!!!

Ask other teachers about anything you may be unsure about.

Asking is **NOT** a sign of inability or incompetence.

"Google" it if you're embarrassed.

Switch Roles for a second



Don't be afraid to let your students teach you!



Be Brave!

Take risks!

Get out of your comfort zone!



Be Sensible!

Start Small.

Don't try to integrate too many digital tools at once.



Beware the Bells and Whistles!

Don't get swept away by
new tools!

You'll spend more time learning the tool than
teaching the content.



“Shop” for new tools

Research new tech tools like you research products on **amazon**

Read reviews, ask colleagues, do your homework!

Companies hire marketing firms to make their products LOOK great, but they might not be as useful as they seem.

Remember why we're here.

When planning, always start with the learning objectives, NOT the tool or app!



Be Smart!

ALWAYS have a plan B!
