#### **REPORTING CHANGES** | Incident Behavior Type and Disciplinary Actions Taken

All incident reporting data will transfer nightly from the SIS.

- All incidents will be reported as single events with each student's disciplinary action linked to the incident. (Legacy reporting required the incident to be repeated for every student involved.)
- Gang-related is no longer an incident, but it will be collected as Secondary Incident Behavior.
- Alternative school placements will be collected as disciplinary actions taken and not incidents. For historical purposes, the following alternative school codes will be recorded as "03072 – Change of placement (long-term)":
  - ASFY Begins School Year in Alternative School
  - ASCO School District approved Court Order
  - ASCP Alternative Education after Corporal Punishment
  - ASGD GED Option
  - ASHS Alternative Education after Suspension
  - ASOS Arrest for Crime off School Property
  - ASPR Parental Request
  - ASRR Remedial Reason
  - ASSA School Attendance
  - ASTS Release from Training School

**Beginning with 2024-25,** all alternate school placements should be reported in one of the "Change of placement" codes above (03072, 03074, 03073, 03075).

- Firearm and weapon types used during an incident will be collected separately from the incident behavior.
- Disciplinary action length difference reason will be collected. This is used when disciplinary action length is modified by a district, a court order, etc. *This data element will be optional for SY 24-25*.

#### WHAT IS REPORTED | Incident Behaviors and Disciplinary Actions Taken that will be reported by the SIS

If the incident contains a non-reportable Incident Behavior **AND** a non-reportable Disciplinary Action Taken, then the SIS **WILL NOT** report the incident to MSIS. Below are a list of non-reportable Incident Behaviors and non-reportable Disciplinary Action Taken and example of incidents that would not be reported.

- Non- Reportable Incident Behaviors: 04704 Violation of School Rules
- Non-Reportable Disciplinary Action: 0999 Other

**INDICDENT:** A student was not following directions from the bus driver while the bus was in motion. The student was not allowed to ride the bus for two days.

If the incident contains a non-reportable Incident Behavior **AND** a reportable Disciplinary Action Taken, then the SIS **WILL** report the incident to MSIS. If the incident contains a reportable Incident Behavior **AND** a non-reportable Disciplinary Action Taken, then the SIS **WILL** report the incident to MSIS. Below are examples of incidents that would be reported.

**INDICDENT:** A student was not following directions from the bus driver while the bus was in motion. Because it was a repeat offense, the student was assigned in-school suspension.


