Quality: Common, correct definition of data elements



Required when the incident type is Weapons Possession or a weapon was involved in the incident:

Handgun - Handgun

Shotgun - Shotgun

Rifle – Rifle

Firearm Type

Required when the incident type is Weapons Possession **and** a firearm was involved in the incident:

Handguns - Handguns

RiflesShotguns - Rifles / Shotguns

Discipline Action Length Difference Reason (OPTIONAL 24/25)

The reason for the difference between the official and actual lengths of a student's disciplinary assignment:

- 01 No Difference
- **02** Term Modified By District
- 03 Term Modified By Court Order

Full Year Expulsion

An expulsion with or without services for a period of one full year (i.e., 365 days).



Incident Injury Type (OPTIONAL 24/25)

An indication of the occurrence of physical injury to participants involved in the incident and the level of injury sustained.

MinorInjury - Minor injury
