The Common Education Data Standards (CEDS) is an education data management initiative whose purpose is to streamline the understanding of data within and across educational institutions and sectors.






Accuracy: Single point of entry for a data element

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





The reason for the difference between the official and actual lengths of a student's disciplinary assignment:

- 01 No Difference
- 02 Term Modified By District
- 03 Term Modified By Court Order

Full Year Expulsion

An expulsion with or without services for a period of one full year (i.e., 365 days).



Incident Injury Type (OPTIONAL 24/25SY)

An indication of the occurrence of physical injury to participants involved in the incident and the level of injury sustained.

- MajorInjury Major injury
- **MinorInjury** Minor injury






Reporting Incidents New MSIS Format





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




Incident: A student was not following directions from the bus driver while the bus was in motion. The student was not allowed to ride the bus for two days.






Incident: A student was not following directions from the bus driver while the bus was in motion. Because it was a repeat offense, the student was assigned in-school suspension.






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Incident: A student was using profanity on the bus. The student was assigned morning detention.


