








Forrest County Agricultural High School 2021-2022 School Year

	<p>Traditional in-person classes will be offered. FCAHS will follow mandates from the Office of the Governor and the Mississippi State Department of Health. Medically fragile students will have access to a homebound option. Limited classes will be offered virtually for seniors only. Seniors who are interested in must complete an application and meet the virtual option criteria.</p>
	<p>The CDC, MSDH, and the FCAHS Board of Trustees strongly recommend face coverings (masks) for both staff and students. Face coverings must follow dress code requirements. Students who are symptomatic should stay home and see their primary care physician. Contact tracing will be conducted this year when a positive case occurs.</p>
	<p>Lunch will be provided in the cafeteria. Sneez guards and touchless hand sanitizing stations will be in place.</p>
	<p>Hand sanitizing stations have been placed in all buildings.</p>
	<p>Students are encouraged to bring refillable water bottles. (No glass containers.) All water fountains have been converted to bottle filling stations.</p>
	<p>School visitors will be limited and must have an appointment.</p>
	<p>Masks are required. Windows will be open. Students will be separated when possible. Buses will be sanitized at the end of each route. Bus notes will NOT be allowed except in extreme emergencies and administration will have the final authority on changes. This includes activity trips.</p>

The superintendent may require masks for all students and staff if needed based on local health trends or changes in state or federal mandates.
