RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Mississippi Department of Education is seeking to employ an Education Program Development Team Lead in the office of Elementary Education and Reading. This position will require an individual to have a master's degree in dyslexia therapy, hold a 203 K-12 license in dyslexia, and be a current Certified Academic Language Therapist (CALT). Must have experience as a dyslexia therapist, knowledgeable of MTSS and preferred experience as an interventionist. This person will be responsible for providing technical support and training in the area of dyslexia to public and special-purpose non-public schools, oversee and manage the dyslexia scholarship and dyslexia grant, work closely with the special purpose non-public schools as they provide student rosters and verify them with The Office of Student Financial Services. This person will be responsible for monitoring the required four-hour dyslexia awareness training sessions that are required for all educators.

EXPERIENCE/EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

Typically requires a relevant Master's Degree, may require certification, and 4+ years of experience.
