13. <u>Approval to award grants to three (3) service providers to provide on-site</u> technical assistance to local school districts as a part of the *Modified Mattie T*. <u>Consent Decree</u> and <u>Individuals with Disabilities Education Act 2004 as</u> represented in the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR)

<u>Purpose</u>: The Mattie T. Implementation Plan was developed in collaboration with Mississippi Department of Education staff and Mattie T. Consultants, with review and input from plaintiffs' counsel. Several activities were developed to ensure that local educational agencies achieve the desired results indicated in the *Modified Mattie T. Consent Decree*. One of the goals for professional development is to establish three (3) Regional Centers and employ six (6) full-time consultants. The responsibilities of these consultants are to provide on-site technical assistance to local school districts identified through focused monitoring as noncompliant in specific areas. The Regional Centers are responsible for assisting districts in monitoring the goals as specified in the *Modified Mattie T. Consent Decree* and *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act 2004 (IDEA 2004)* as represented in the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Plan (SPP/APR).

## Scope of Grant:

•	Grant Period:	July 1, 2012 – June 30, 2013
•	Award Amount:	\$465,230
•	Method of Award:	Application

<u>Funding Source</u>: Special Education Grant to States (IDEA Part B). The amount of funding by grantee is based upon the original funding application.

A competitive process was used during the grant implementation year using a funding application. In subsequent years, each grantee submits specific reports by the required deadline in order to continue their grant as indicated below.
