10. Approval to contract with WestEd to develop resources and conduct training modules on the effective use of data literacy skills in decision making and instruction

Awarded Vendor: WestEd  
San Francisco, California

Scope of Project: WestEd will develop customized resources and conduct an 8-day “Using Data Institute” for Priority Schools. These face-to-face professional development activities are designed to support Priority School leadership teams with the goal of making data driven decisions to attain instructional excellence. The proposed training modules are built around each participating school’s data and provide hands-on experience using data tools. At the conclusion of the “Using Data Institute”, the distributed model of training will enable the participants to apply data analysis skills to improve academic results for students. Participants will be offered continuous support throughout the 2012-2013 school year.
