Proposed Recommendations for the 2012-2013 State Accountability System

The Accountability Task Force is proposing that the following be applied to the state component of the statewide accountability system for the 2012-2013 school year:

1) All Schools/Districts:

• The use of A, B, C, D, F will replace the use of Star, High Performing, Successful, Academic Watch, Low Performing, At-Risk of Failing and Failing.

2) Schools/District without a 12th grade:

Apply the QDI cut points from the previous years.

• Growth will continue to be applied as in previous years.

3) Schools/Districts with a 12th grade:

- The use of the High School Completion Index (HSCI) will be discontinued.
- Growth will be calculated using the same formulas as in the 2011-2012 school year but applied as listed in the table below.
- The school /district 4-year graduation rate will be converted into a point value then added to the school/district QDI for a new High School Value and applied as follows:

Example: A high school with a QDI of 205 and a 4-year graduation rate of 75% (75 points) would have a High School Value of 280. If the school does <u>not</u> meet Growth, it is a "B" school. If the school <u>does</u> meet Growth, the school is an "A" school.

4) Science 5/8 and US History

In keeping with the current accountability standards and state board policies, Grades 5 and 8 Science and US History will be included in the achievement component.
