13. Approval of methodology to reallocate Neglected and Delinquent State Agency and Local Educational Agency program funds in accordance with Section 1401

Purpose: Title I, Part D, Subparts 1 and 2 funds ensure that Neglected and Delinquent (N and D) students receive a free and appropriate public education and enable their success by eliminating barriers through providing supplemental educational needs and services.

Eligibility: All local educational agencies (LEA) and state agencies (SA) that received an initial Title I, Part D Subpart 1 or 2 allocation are eligible to receive reallocation funds. Any LEA or SA that has relinquished funds due to facility closures, non-acceptance of allocated funds, and/or reductions for not meeting maintenance of effort will not be eligible to receive additional funds.

Funding Source: Neglected and Delinquent Program (Title I, Part D, Subparts 1 and 2)

Basis for Awarding the Grants: Formula

Funds will be awarded based on the following methodology:

I. Per Pupil Allocation Amount:

Each LEA will receive an allocation based upon the per pupil amount. The per pupil allocation amount will be calculated as follows:

$$\frac{\textit{Title I, Part D funds Available for Reallocation}}{\textit{Total Neglected and Delinquent Count}} = \textit{Per Pupil Allocation Amount}$$

II. LEA Allocation Amount:

The per pupil allocation amount will be multiplied by the Total Neglected and Delinquent Count to determine the allocation for each LEA or SA and calculated as follows:

$$\textit{Per Pupil Allocation Amount} \times \textit{Total N and D Count} = \textit{LEA Allocation Amount}$$
