#### 16. <u>Approval to begin the Administrative Procedure Act process: To establish CTE</u> endorsement codes for Television Broadcasting and Production and Cosmetology

Background Information:

The Office of Secondary Education is requesting approval of two new endorsement codes. The codes are:

- 958 Career Pathway: Television Broadcasting and Production
- 959 Career Pathway: Cosmetology

The curricula and courses for these programs of study are undergoing revisions and updates. Licensure requirements have been modified to align with programs of study revisions. Primary changes for all applicants include: a) the College and Career Readiness Educator Program (CCREP) option, b) completion of an online learning certification, and c) completion of required program of study certification.

The Commission on Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and Licensure and Development approved the new endorsement codes on September 7, 2014.
