In accordance with Section 37-9-18, Mississippi Code Annotated, 1972, on March 11, 2014, because of a deficit fund balance in the General Fund at June 30, 2013, we notified you of a serious financial condition at Carroll County School District. As a result, a financial advisor was assigned to the School District. Based on the results of an audit of Carroll County School District for the year ended June 30, 2014, and a Report on the Financial Condition of the School District, prepared by the financial advisor, you have now concluded that the serious financial condition no longer exists at Carroll County School District.

We recently reviewed and approved the completed audit report of Carroll County School District for the year ended June 30, 2014, audited by Cunningham CPAs, PLLC, Certified Public Accountants. The audit report reflects a deficit fund balance in the General Fund in the amount of \$1,178,290 and advances from the Sixteenth Section Principal Fund to the General Fund in the amount of \$1,331,397. Because the advances were sufficient in amount to more than offset the General Fund deficit, according to our established criteria, we concur that the serious financial condition no longer exists at Carroll County School District.
