20. Approval to modify grant awards for the Teacher Incentive Fund (TIF) Grant

Purpose: In 2010, the Mississippi Department of Education was awarded a federal grant. One component of the grant was the development and implementation of a system that would provide financial incentives to eligible licensed personnel for meeting or exceeding growth targets. The amount of awards is determined by the level of growth in each incentive category; therefore, grant modifications vary from school to school.

The grants are being modified to increase funds to pay incentives as outlined in the grant.

Scope of Grant:

- Current Grant Period: August 22, 2011 – December 31, 2014
- Modified Grant Period: August 22, 2011 – December 31, 2015
- Current Award Amount: \$ 3,581,402.45
- Modification Increase: \$ 2,428,915.97
- Total Modified Award Amount: \$ 6,010,318.42
- Method of Award: Discretionary Grants

Funding Source: 2010 Teacher Incentive Fund Grant
