OFFICE OF ACCREDITATION

18. <u>Discussion of days missed by school districts as a result of inclement</u> weather during school year 2013-2014

Pursuant to MS Code 37-13-63, the State Board of Education is authorized to allow a school district to alter its calendar on a case-by-case basis in the event of a natural disaster or extreme weather emergency in which the Governor has declared a state of emergency. If a school board of any school district shall determine that it is not economically feasible or practicable to operate any school within the district for the full one hundred eighty (180) days required for a full school term as required in Section 37-13-63 of the *Mississippi Code* and Standard 19 as published in the *Mississippi Public School Accountability Standards*, said school board may notify the State Department of Education of such disaster or weather emergency and submit a request to alter the school term.

Emergency weather conditions resulting from sleet, snow, and ice associated with the winter storms have caused several school districts in our state to miss days during the 2013-2014 school year.

In accordance with Section 37-13-63, the State Board of Education may permit the school board to operate in its district for less than 180 days.

Dear Mr. Ivey,

I completed the online survey *Inclement Weather Data Collection Form*, but would like to provide you with additional information via this email.

On Monday, January 27, 2014, Governor Bryant declared a State of Emergency to prepare for winter weather conditions across south Mississippi. Because of the winter storm, on Tuesday, January 28, 2014, the Governor declared a State of Emergency for thirty-six (36) counties. Marion County, in which the Columbia School District is located, was one of the counties listed in the disaster declaration. Due to the prolonged freezing conditions and icy roadways, the Columbia School District was closed from January 28 through January 30, 2014.

We believe that instruction and student learning are critical to academic success, and we work diligently to ensure a high level of accountability. Although current law and standards require five hours (330 minutes) of actual teaching, instructional minutes among the four schools in our district range from 360 to 425 minutes. At a minimum, our students receive thirty (30) minutes more of instruction each day than is actually required. At our high school, students receive one hour and thirty-five minutes more per day than required.

Additionally, we believe it would not be economically feasible or practical to make up the days missed because of additional operating costs and an anticipated high rate of student and employee absenteeism. It is estimated that the district would save an estimated \$27,815 in salaries, \$6,731 in benefits, \$8,282 in utilities, \$2,053 in fuel, and \$8,478 in food by not making up the days missed.

The Columbia School District Board of Trustees will meet on February 13, 2014, to consider a request to ask the State Board of Education to "forgive" the days missed. The Board will also consider a revised school year calendar in the event the State Board does not approve the request regarding the days missed.

As you are aware, Governor Bryant declared a *State of Emergency* due to the recent winter weather conditions and the Lawrence County School District is located in one of the affected areas. Due to conditions making it unsafe for our students and employees to travel, our schools and administrative offices were closed January 28th, 29th and 30th.
