05. Approval to modify grant awards for FY14 in support of local improvement efforts in current School Improvement Grant (SIG) schools as authorized under Section 1003(g) of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965*

Purpose: The grant is being modified to increase the funds previously awarded for FY14 as authorized under Section 1003(g) of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965*. Year three awards for Cohort II schools are being modified to increase the allocations due to unexpended funds from previous awards.

All seven current SIG schools were eligible to apply; however, only five of those did so. School personnel completed Enhancement applications to describe intended expenditures for the additional funds which slightly exceeded the available amount. Office of School Recovery staff reduced the requested amounts based on a review of needs, proposed budget, and current allocation.

Scope of Grant:

- Current Grant Period: July 1, 2011 – September 30, 2014
- Current Award Amount: \$ 16,353,427.38
- Modification Increase: \$ 1,081,643.31
- Total Modified Award Amount: \$ 17,435,070.69
- Method of Award Enhancement Applications
- Funding Source: School Improvement Grants, Recovery Act and School Improvement Grants
