09. Approval to award discretionary grants to school districts for the purpose of contracting with Educators in Residence to provide consultative services and technical assistance

Purpose: To provide practitioner expertise, technical assistance, and capacity building for the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) in the areas of:

- Principal evaluations.
- Literacy in accordance with the Literacy-Based Promotion Act.
- Consultative services and technical assistance concerning statewide assessments.

Discretionary grants will be awarded to school districts in support of the Educator in Residence program through which services of the MDE to local school districts will be enhanced.

Scope of Grant:

- Grant Period: July 1, 2014 – June 30, 2015
- Maximum Award Amount: \$2,777,827

- Method of Award: Discretionary
