<u>Scope of Project</u>: The project evaluation for Realizing Excellence for All Children in Mississippi (REACH MS) will focus on the achievement of the specific project goals and objectives as measured by the USDOE's performance indicators for the fourth year of a five-year procurement.

REACH MS focuses primarily on supporting school-wide and district-wide implementation of Positive Behavioral Intervention and Support (PBIS) at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. REACH MS is implemented through the University of Southern Mississippi and MDE serves as the fiscal agent.
