To the extent that the Contractor's delay or nonperformance is excused under Paragraph (4) (Excuse for Nonperformance or Delayed Performance) of the Termination for Default Clause of this contract, liquidated damages shall not be due the State. The Contractor remains liable for damages caused other than by delay. If the Mississippi Department of Education requests changes that cause delays, Renaissance Learning shall be held harmless from the liquidated damages.
