<u>Scope of Project</u>: The original contract language for Cambium Education, Inc., dba Sopris Learning, indicated an option to renew an additional two years beyond the original ending date of June 30, 2014. This contract renewal includes year two (first additional year) to pay for service to provide training for teachers and administrators.

The contractor is responsible for the total operation and management of the K-3 Literacy Training to build content and pedagogical knowledge of the essential elements of literacy and provide strategies for supporting effective reading instruction.

Personnel associated with this contract are not former Department employees or related to any Department employees.

<u>Basis for Contract</u>: Section 37-177-19 of the Mississippi Code authorizes the Mississippi Department of Education to provide technical assistance as may be needed to aid local school districts in administering the provisions of the legislation.

Training Overview
