09. Approval of the Mississippi School of the Arts (MSA) to host a summer arts camp and participate in the summer feeding program

The Mississippi School of the Arts (MSA) requests permission to host its first summer camp and to participate in the summer feeding program through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the MDE Office of Child Nutrition. The purpose of the camp is to provide students with the opportunity to receive intensive arts training in creative writing, dance, theatre, visual art, and vocal music as part of MSA's outreach efforts. Students will study two art forms of their choice. This camp will take place on the campus of MSA on June 1-6, 2014, for up to 125 students in 8th- 10th grade. Registration will be on a first-come first-served basis. The registration cost for a residential student is \$395, and the cost for a commuter student is \$195. The registration cost will cover most of the camp expenses. Additional camp expenses will be offset through a grant from the Mississippi Arts Commission and through the MSA Foundation.
