07. Approval to revise Process Standard 20 – Instructional Management System, of the Mississippi Public School Accountability Standards, 2014 [Goals 2 and 4 – MDE Strategic Plan]

(Has cleared the Administrative Procedures Act Process with public comments)

On April 14, 2015, the Commission on School Accreditation approved the proposed revisions to Process Standards 20 – *Instructional Management System*, of the *Mississippi Public School Accountability Standards, 2014.*

The Office of Elementary Education presented proposed revisions to Process Standard 20, *Instructional Management System*, to the Commission on School Accreditation for approval.

Process Standard 20 is being revised to emphasize the following requirements of the Instructional Management System:

- 1) Requires approval of the local school board;
- 2) Includes the competencies and objectives required in the curriculum frameworks approved by the State Board of Education;
- 3) The frameworks are available to all teachers;
- 4) Includes a tiered instructional model in accordance with State Board Policy 4300, including academic and behavioral interventions, and
- 5) Meets requirements of the Literacy-Based Promotion Act.

This item references Goals 2 and 4 of the *Mississippi Department of Education* 2016-2020 Strategic Plan.

 - 20.1 The instructional management system includes the competencies and objectives required in the curriculum frameworks approved by the State Board of Education that are available to all teachers in each school.
 - 20.2 The instructional management system includes a tiered instructional model in accordance with State Board of Education Policy 4300, including academic interventions, behavioral interventions, and *Literacy-Based Promotion Act* requirements.
