16. <u>Action: Renew the contract with Questar Assessment, Inc., for the Mississippi Assessment Program – Alternate (MAP-A) [Goal 1 – MBE Strategic Plan]</u>

Awarded Vendor: Questar Assessment, Inc. Apple Valley, Minnesota

Scope of Project: This contractor will provide programmatic, technical, and psychometric activities for an assessment being developed to measure the extended, Mississippi College- and Career-Ready Standards (MSCCR). This assessment is administered to students with the most significant cognitive disabilities in a manner that provides information about: (a) an individual student's understanding of the MSCCR, (b) supports needed to improve learning outcomes, and (c) effective instructional practices.

Renewal of contract for years three (3) through ten (10) will be determined annually and shall be contingent upon the successful completion of the preceding year's contract and the availability of funds. Personnel associated with this contract are not former Department employees or related to any Department employees.
