G. Action: Contract with vendor for the operation of the Mississippi K-3 Literacy Professional Development Training System [Goal 1 - MBE Strategic Plan]

Awarded Vendor: Voyager Sopris Learning, Inc.  
Dallas, TX

Scope of Project: The Literacy-Based Promotion Act was established for students enrolled in Mississippi public schools to achieve grade-level reading by the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. The Mississippi Department of Education is responsible for providing technical assistance and training for teachers and administrators as may be needed to aid local school districts in administering the provisions of the legislation.

The K-3 literacy training procured through this contract will build content and pedagogical knowledge of the essential elements of literacy and provide strategies for supporting effective reading instruction.

Renewal of contract for years two through five will be determined annually and shall be contingent upon the successful completion of the preceding year's contract and the availability of funds. Personnel associated with this contract are not former Department employees or related to any Department employees.

Scope of Contract:

- Term of Contract: July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017
- Total Amount to be Awarded: Amount not to exceed \$1,500,000
- Method of Award: Request for Proposals

Funding Source: State Funds

Summary of Selection Process:

A competitive selection process was utilized to award this contract.

- A. Ability to perform services (training and capacity)
- B. Personnel, Equipment, & Facilities
- C. Record of past performance

- D. Plan for performing services
- E. Price

Mississippi teachers and administrators responsible for Kindergarten – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students, as well as literacy coaches, higher education faculty, and pre-service teachers can participate in the Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling (LETRS) training modules focused on improving literacy instruction. The training is conducted in three phases with a blend of online and face-to-face sessions. The composition of each phase and projected participant count are in the charts below.
