C. <u>Renew grants to school districts to support Kindergarten through 3rd grade</u> <u>literacy instruction and intensive intervention</u>

<u>Purpose</u>: The K-3 Literacy Support Grants will support local schools with implementation of the *Literacy-Based Promotion Act*. Funds must be used to assist in improving literacy outcomes for students in grades K-3. Acceptable expenditures include, but are not limited to:

- Purchasing evidence-based intervention programs, summer literacy programs, and leveled reading materials or reading manipulatives.
- Purchasing professional development specific to intensive evidence-based reading interventions.
- Funding for local literacy coaches or interventionists working directly with teachers and students in the area of literacy.

This renewal is for the third and final year of a three-year grant. All school districts were eligible to apply during the application period in the fall of 2014. Schools that receive literacy coaching support were eligible for up to \$25,000 annually, and schools without coaching support were eligible for up to \$50,000 annually. At the time of original grant award, 34 grants were awarded, with one school having closed since that time.
