M. Renew the Fiscal Year 2018 contract with Questar Assessment, Inc. for the Mississippi Assessment Program – Alternate (MAP-A)

Awarded Vendor: Questar Assessment, Inc.

<u>Scope of Project</u>: This contractor will provide programmatic, technical, and psychometric activities for an assessment being developed to measure the extended, MS College and Career Readiness Standards (MSCCR). This assessment is administered to students with the most significant cognitive disabilities in a manner that provides information about: (a) an individual student's understanding of the MSCCR, (b) supports needed to improve learning outcomes, and (c) effective instructional practices.

Renewal of contract for years four through ten will be determined annually and shall be contingent upon the successful completion of the preceding year's contract and the availability of funds. Personnel associated with this contract are not former Department employees or related to any Department employees. This contract will not be considered renewable where legislative changes impact the implementation of said contract.

<u>Technical Note:</u> The proposed MAP-A cost for FY18 is a <u>decrease</u> of \$1,000,000. The \$1,000,000 decrease is a result of removing standard setting, which occurred in year one, as well as, a reduction in training fees pertaining to the rental of facilities.

Questar Assessment, Inc. will continue to create a custom alternate assessment (MAP-A) that measures the alternate academic achievement standards. This fiscal year, teachers will participate in item writer workshops to continue the creation of items appropriate for the most vulnerable population, as well as, a training package to ensure teachers are properly trained on the custom assessments. This alternate assessment (MAP-A) will continue to be consistent with both quality and direction of the Mississippi Assessment Program (MAP).
