05.F. Action: Award competitive grants for the Non-Profit Workforce Professional Development Grant Program [Goal 4– MBE Strategic Plan]

Background and Purpose: The Office of Career and Technical Education is seeking to award grant dollars to non-profit entities for professional development in the areas of workforce development, economics education and advanced placement studies. Awards are renewable for up to three years contingent upon successful performance and funding availability. The purpose of the Non-Profit Workforce Professional Development grant is to support and expand efforts to recruit, train, and retain quality educators for Mississippi districts in the areas of workforce development, economics education and advanced placement studies.

Scope of Grant:

- Grant Period: December 16, 2021 – June 30, 2024
(with a liquidation period ending July 15, 2024)

- Award Amount: \$200,000 - Year 1
\$200,000 - Year 2
\$200,000 - Year 3

- Method of Award: Request for Proposals

Funding Source: State funds

Summary of Selection Process:

A competitive grant selection process was utilized to award the grants.

Scoring Criteria:

- A. Program Training
- B. Observation and Assessment
- C. Curriculum Development
- D. Mentoring
- E. Budget
