# Minutes of Mississippi Board of Education Meeting

## August 19, 2021

The members of the Mississippi Board of Education met in a Board meeting at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 19, 2021, via teleconference and video means pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 25-41-5 for the purpose of conducting the Board meeting.

The meeting was available to the public via live stream.<sup>1</sup> Board members present: Ms. Rosemary G. Aultman (Clinton, Mississippi), Dr. Wendi Barrett (Biloxi, Mississippi), Dr. Angela Bass (Jackson, Mississippi), Mr. Glen V. East (Gulfport, Mississippi), Mr. Bill Jacobs (Brookhaven, Mississippi), Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee (Madison, Mississippi), Mr. Matt Miller (Hattiesburg, Mississippi), and Ms. Mary Werner (Saltillo, Mississippi). Board member absent: Dr. Karen J. Elam. Student Representatives absent: Ms. Amy Zhang and Ms. Micah Hill. Dr. Carey M. Wright was present at Central High School Building, 359 North West Street, Jackson, Mississippi.

- Ms. Rosemary G. Aultman called the Board meeting to order at 10:05 a.m., after determining that a quorum of the Board existed at the locations stated for the purpose of conducting a meeting through teleconference and video means in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 25-41-5.
- II. Mr. Bill Jacobs led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mr. Matt Miller gave the Invocation.
- III. On a motion by Mr. Bill Jacobs, seconded by Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee, the Board voted unanimously to approve the July 15, 2021, Board meeting minutes and the August 3, 2021, Special-called Board meeting minutes.
- IV. On a motion by Ms. Mary Werner, seconded by Mr. Glen V. East, the Board voted unanimously to approve the agenda as presented.
- V. Dr. Carey M. Wright gave the following report as the State Superintendent of Education:
  - Dr. Wright stated she attended the National Assessment Governing Board for the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), and the Reading Framework was approved, and it will be used for the 2026 NAEP assessment. Dr. Wright stated that MDE will make sure to distribute the Framework to our teachers.
  - Dr. Thomas Dobbs conducted a webinar on Friday with the superintendents and the local board members that could attend, and he gave them updated

- information on what is happening around the state with COVID and encouraged them to continue to adhere to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Department of Health Guidelines. Dr. Wright stated that he encouraged everyone that could to get vaccinated.
- Dr. Wright stated she met with the telehealth and teletherapy workgroup that she has been working with for a year now and they are getting very close to finalizing the equipment needs and then they will be putting that in as a pilot in 11 school districts this fall with the intent to scale up at a later date.
- Dr. Wright stated that she attended the Children's Health Council with agency heads and Dr. Dobbs sits on this Council also and this is a way to keep an eye on what is happening around the state and any policy issues that may need to be addressed.
- Dr. Wright stated that she and Dr. Paula Vanderford were invited to speak on a podcast with the Louisiana Pelican Public Policy Institute. Dr. Wright stated that Louisiana is getting ready to revise their accountability model and they wanted to know about Mississippi's model since Mississippi has continued to see success.
- Dr. Wright stated that she brought greetings to the next cohort of Teach Plus.
- Dr. Wright stated that Mr. Bill Jacobs invited her to the Brookhaven Splitterism Club, and she gave them some information and some great talking points about what is going on in Mississippi.
- Dr. Wright stated that she and Mr. Pete Smith were invited by the State Superintendent of Alaska to come to Alaska and speak to all his superintendents and speak to the joint Senate and House Education Committee. Dr. Wright stated they are looking at Mississippi's success and looking at our legislation since they are 51st in the Nation and they want to know about Mississippi's strategies and our legislation. Dr. Wright stated that at their expense, she and Mr. Smith flew to Alaska and spoke to all the superintendents one day and then met with the joint Senate and House Education Committee and we are continuing to assist in their efforts to draft legislation and their strategies that they are trying to imply to improve literacy in the state of Alaska.
- Dr. Wright stated that MDE advertised earlier in July for Interim
  Superintendents since the Interim Superintendent in Noxubee left to take a
  job in Detroit, and the agency is trying to get ahead of that and advertised
  for that position and Dr. Washington Cole is currently serving in this capacity
  on an interim basis. Dr. Wright stated that the Board hired Dr. Jennifer
  Wilson to assume the Interim Superintendent position in the Holmes County
  Consolidated School District.
- Dr. Wright stated MDE is getting ready to launch the Equipped Book List for All. Dr. Wright stated that this is a book list for teachers for grades 6-12 for all kinds of social issues, content issues, and they are using this as an opportunity for teachers to use books on this list to build children's content and background knowledge and as of this week MDE is launching grades K-

5 so all teachers grade K-12 will have this amazing list of books from which to choose. Dr. Wright stated that the books are noted if they are award winning books, noted by Lexile, noted by length, and there is a summary of each book. Dr. Wright gave a shout out to the many people that have been working on this project: Dr. Nathan Oakley, Dr. Marla Davis, Dr. Tenette Smith, Dr. Kristen Wynn, Ms. LeighAnne Cheeseman, Ms. Elizabeth Simmons, Ms. Melissa Banks, Ms. Wendy Clemons, Ms. Tammy Crosetti, Ms. Natalie Crowder, Dr. Lea Johnson, Dr. Kristina Livingston, Ms. Jasmine Bell, Ms. Jen Cornett, Ms. Sandy Elliott, Mr. Limuel Eubanks, Dr. Kevin Gaylor, Ms. Melanie Watkins, Ms. Amy Baker, Ms. Natalie Breithaupt, Ms. Coretta Doss, Ms. Aimee Hawkins, Ms. Molly Henderson, Ms. Nicole Hunter, Ms. Stephanie Mollett, Ms. Tiffany Nickleberry, Ms. Kimberely Peterman, Ms. Kasey Rather, Ms. LaTondra Robinson, Ms. Christine Spell, Ms. Missaha Thompson, and Ms. Delphony Williams. Dr. Wright stated that she would also like to extend thanks to public school counselors who helped with the Social Emotional Learning (SEL) review and the selection of titles to support SEL. Dr. Wright thanked parents, including foster parents, who reviewed for appropriateness and who suggested additional titles for consideration. Dr. Wright thanked the various groups of Mississippi public school teachers, librarians, and administrators who assisted MDE in both rating and identifying the titles chosen for this list and for providing feedback throughout the development process.
