This method determines the high school completion status for students four (4) years after entering Grade 9 for the first time during the school year (SY) 2018-2019 (Seniors SY 2021-2022) and graduated within the cohort window which ended July 31, 2022.

Also, included are the 2023 dropout rates for all students and the graduation and dropout rates for students with disabilities.







Comparison of the 2023 State Level Graduation and Dropout Rates For All Students and Students with Disabilities






