## Minutes of Mississippi Board of Education Meeting

## September 17, 2024

The members of the Mississippi Board of Education met at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 17, 2024, pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 25-41-5 for the purpose of conducting a regularly scheduled Board meeting.

The public accessed this meeting via livestream or in-person at the Central High School Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Boardroom, 359 North West Street, Jackson, Mississippi. Board members physically present included: Mr. Glen V. East, Mr. Bill Jacobs, Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee, Mr. Matt Miller, Mr. Mike Pruitt, and Ms. Mary Werner. Board member attending virtually: Ms. Billye Jean Stroud (New Albany, Mississippi). Board members absent: Dr. Wendi Barrett and Mr. Matt Mayo. Student Representatives present: Ms. Kate Riddle and Mr. Crosby Parker. Dr. Lance Evans, State Superintendent, was also present.

- I. Mr. Glen V. East called the Board meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., after determining that a quorum of the Board existed for the purpose of conducting a meeting.
- II. Mr. East led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the Invocation.
- III. On a motion by Ms. Mary Werner, seconded by Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of August 15, 2024 Board meeting.
- IV. On a motion by Mr. Matt Miller, seconded by Ms. Mary Werner, the Board approved the Consent Agenda.
  - On a motion by Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee, seconded by Mr. Bill Jacobs, the Board approved the agenda as presented.
- V. No Recognition Ceremony.
- VI. Dr. Lance Evans gave the following report as the State Superintendent of Education:
  - Dr. Evans stated the Regional Superintendents meetings for Meridian, Jackson, Oxford, and Cleveland have been completed. Dr. Evans stated that this week the Regional Superintendents meetings will be held in Hattiesburg and Gulfport. Dr. Evans stated the first Teacher Advisory Council will meet in Gulfport since it was rescheduled due to the weather.
  - Dr. Evans stated that MDE had meetings with the superintendents of Holmes County Consolidated School District, Noxubee County School District, and the Achievement School District (Humphreys County School District and Yazoo City Municipal School District).

- Dr. Evans stated he visited the Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science along with House Education Chair Rob Roberson, House Education Vice-Chair Kent McCarty, Representative Donnie Scoggin, and Mr. Cole Butler from House Speaker Jason White's Office. Dr. Evans thanked Mr. Mike Pruitt for joining the group. Dr. Evans stated MDE will be working with legislators on funding and other support for the school.
- Dr. Evans stated he had the following speaking engagements:
  - Mississippi Horizons Conference by AccelerateMS: On panel with Patrick Sullivan, Chair of the State Workforce Investment Board (SWIB), and Kell Smith, Executive Director of the Mississippi Community College Board about how our agencies can streamline workforce development efforts and ensure equitable access to CTE programs;
  - State Workforce Investment Board (SWIB): Highlighted national certification passing percentages and CTE expenditure data;
  - Clinton Rotary Club: Presented with Clinton School District Superintendent Dr. Andy Scoggin to answer questions about school choice; and
  - PREPS CEO Leadership Academy: Spoke to 50 principals and assistant principals who are part of the year-long PREPS CEO Leadership Academy.
- Dr. Evans stated he attended legislative/stakeholder meetings:
  - PEER Committee: Biennial review of Education Scholarship Account (ESA) program MDE administrators;
  - Florida Harm Prevention Model: Met at Rankin County School District with staff and education stakeholders to learn about the Model and he thanked Dr. Ronnie L. McGehee for participating in the meeting;
  - Mississippi Association of School Business Officers (MASBO):
    Mentoring program proposal for new school business administrators;
  - AccelerateMS: Provided Executive Director Courtney Taylor an overview of the statewide accountability system and current considerations for updating the model;
  - Foundation for Excellence in Education (ExelinEd) State Chiefs convening in North Carolina: Met with ExcelinEd leaders and my counterparts from around the country;
  - Mississippi College Board: Possible K12/Adult Education partnership to address statewide low adult literacy rates;
  - College Board: Preview of Mississippi's PSAT, SAT, and AP results to be released publicly September 24;
  - Mississippi Public Broadcasting (MPB): Discussed partnership to develop comprehensive distance learning program staffed by Mississippi teachers hired to teach remotely; and
  - o Code.org: Met with state government relations director.

IX. Report on State Board of Education Subcommittee meeting

Mr. Glen V. East, Chair, Academic Achievement PreK-12/Early Childhood Subcommittee, stated they met yesterday and heard outstanding plans in early childhood education. Mr. East stated MDE is looking at the way we measure effectiveness of our early childhood programs especially those involved in the grants. Mr. East stated MDE is trying to outline some ideas to not only make sure that our children are ready for kindergarten in math and reading but also in what is called executive skills which is being able to solve problems, being able to share, and being able to do those things that make a good human being. Mr. East stated MDE is getting ready to move forward with the process and will bring the document to the Board to begin the Administrative Procedures Act (APA) process soon.
