F. Approval of an Accredited-Temporary Status for Oxford University School - Oxford

Background Information: Based on Policy 2.3 of the *Mississippi Nonpublic Accountability Standards, 2019*, an Accredited-Temporary status may be assigned to a satellite school established by the governing body of an accredited nonpublic school currently on record with the State Board of Education.

New Learning Resources Inc., in Jackson has acquired the Oxford University School in Oxford, an independent day school dedicated to academic, physical, and creative excellence while nurturing children to become leaders. Oxford University School is a secular college preparatory school that currently serves children from 2 years old through eighth grade. The school focuses on academic excellence and the development of good citizens and well-rounded students that love learning.

Oxford University School is staffed with a full-time principal, (1) Certified Counselor, (1) Certified Librarian, (3) Dyslexia Specialist, (3) Pre-K Teachers with (3) Assistance, (1) 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Teacher, (1) 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Grade Teacher and (1) 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade Teacher. Currently, 68 students are enrolled.
