03.A. <u>Action: Modify the funding amount of the Educator-in-Residence (EIR) grants to school districts for literacy coaches</u> [Goals 1, 2, and 4 – MBE Strategic Plan]

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: To extend the reach of the MDE to provide practitioner expertise, technical assistance, and capacity building across the state in the area of literacy in accordance with the Literacy-Based Promotion Act.

Grants will be modified to include the increase in State Retirement benefits that became effective July 1, 2019 and will compensate the awarded school districts in support of the Educator-in-Residence program. With an optional four-year renewal period based on performance evaluations with the grant ending June, 30, 2024.
