03.A. Action: Approval of grant awards for the School Nurse Intervention Grants, as identified in the Mary Kirkpatrick-Haskell, Mary Sprayberry School Nurse Program, Miss. Code Ann. § 37-14-3 and funded by legislative appropriation [Goals 1 and 2 - MBE Strategic Plan]

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: In 2007 the Mississippi Legislature created the Mary-Kirkpatrick-Haskell, Mary Sprayberry Act, Public School Nurse Program, Miss. Code Ann. § 37-14-3. The program receives an annual legislative appropriation for the purpose of continued support for the School Nurse Intervention Program. The Office of Healthy Schools has awarded seventy-two (72) grants based on successful competitive grant applications. Any school district may have received up to two grant awards. The grant funds of \$42,500 for each grant are distributed each year with up to four annual installments based on legislative appropriation and completion of grant requirements. Annual mandates include budget and school nurse program narratives.

Modified Grant Period: August 1, 2020 – June 30, 2024

• Current Award Amount: \$ 3,060,000.00

Modification Increase: \$ 12,240,000.00
