C. <u>Approval of methodology to award grant funds to local school districts for the CTE Non-traditional Participation Grant Program</u>

<u>Background and Purpose</u>: The Carl D. Perkins Act (Perkins) requires \$60,000.00 to \$150,000.00 of the funds designated for State leadership activities be made available for services that prepare individuals for non-traditional fields. The purpose of the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Non-traditional Participation Grant Program is to increase enrollment, recruitment, retention, and opportunities for success in non-traditional CTE programs.

<u>Eligibility</u>: All secondary local educational agencies with approved Perkins Local Plan Applications are eligible to apply through a Request for Proposal (RFP) competitive process.

Funding Source: Federal

Basis for Awarding the Grants: Competitive The amount of the awards will be \$3,000.00.

<u>Funding will be awarded based on the following methodology</u>: Proposals will be reviewed and scored by an Evaluation Team using a 100-point scale. Proposals with the highest scores will be funded until funds are depleted. The 100-point scoring criteria includes the following four components.

Project Narrative (50 points)
Collaboration & Support (15 points)
Project Evaluation (20 points)
Budget Information (15 points)
