05.A. Action: Award competitive grants for K-8 STEM Initiative Enhancement Project
[Goal 2 – MBE Strategic Plan]

Background and Purpose: As the Mississippi Legislature appropriates funds, the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) seeks local educational agencies (LEAs) that will provide technology upgrades and educator training to implement all components of Mississippi College- and Career-Readiness Standards for Science through agricultural programs, computer science, engineering or robotic engineering programs and STEM programs. These funds are being awarded to LEAs to ensure that these programs are provided with the opportunities to ensure their academic success.

Scope of Grant:

- Grant Period: March 1, 2021 – June 30, 2021
(With a liquidation period ending July 15, 2021)
- Award Amount: \$ 440,000
- Method of Award: Request for Proposals

Funding Source: State funds
