Prior Care

Childcare- Licensed child care facilities that care for children from typically 6 weeks old to 5 years old for full time care. After the children start school, they provide after school care. This provider offers year around care.

Family care- Child care provided in a home that the caregiver lives in and cares for children during the day. The person caring for the child could be a family member or neighbor.

Head Start- This is a federally funded holistic family and child education program. Head Start begins serving children as an infant at some sites. The majority of Head Start sites serve three and four-year-old children for a school year term.

Home- The child stays at home with a parent or caregiver until they enter school.

Pre-K public- This program would fall under the Title I pre-k or Collaborative pre-k program in a public school.

Pre-K private- This program would be housed in a private school.
