

# MATHEMATICS SUPPORT SCHOOLS 2023-2024

## Provided by MDE Math Coaching Coordinators

The MDE will expand coaching supports in 2023-2024 to help mitigate learning loss that has occurred over time. The MDE has created a Math Coaching Department who will work in schools focusing on delivering professional development and coaching services to teachers and administrators that will improve student outcomes across the state. Mathematics Coach Coordinators will support educators in effectively implementing the Mississippi College- and Career-Readiness Standards, utilizing the MDE Coaching Model to foster change and instructional improvement in assigned schools.

### Responsibilities of the Mathematics Coach Coordinators:

- Conduct in-person and virtual math coaching
- Review, establish and/or create individualized plans of action
- Travel weekly to schools to provide in-person modeling and co-teaching
- Engage in classroom observations and walk-throughs
- Assist with lesson plan development focusing on HQIM (if applicable)
- Provide professional development opportunities for selected teachers
- Facilitate summer enrichment for administrators and teachers
