Tentative Timeline (July 15, 2013)

Listed below is a **Tentative** Timeline for Hazlehurst City School District to exit from conservatorship. Please understand that any deviation, concerns, or problems can alter this **Tentative** Timeline.

- Mississippi Board of Education determines impairments have been substantially corrected and Governor declares an emergency no longer exists.
- On or before July 31, 2013, MBE notifies the governing authority (Mayor and City Council) of its action and requests for the appointment of School Board members.
- On or before July 31, 2013, MBE also notifies the Circuit Clerk and Election Commissioners.
- The Mayor and City Council appoint the Board members, including the two elected positions. The Board members appointed from the added territory must meet the requirements of a Board member elected from the added territory.
- Appointments will fill unexpired terms, allowing for staggered terms except the 2 Board members from the added territory only serve until the next general election following appointment.
- Board members take office.

- MSBA conducts training for new Board members.
 - Advertise in different publications for applicants for superintendent.
 - Interview applicants for Superintendent.
 - The newly formed School Board appoints the Superintendent of the reconstituted municipal separate school district with the assistance of the Conservator.
 - On or before July 1, 2014, the Superintendent takes office and the Conservator leaves. The Conservator remains in control and administration of the schools until the Superintendent officially takes office.
