

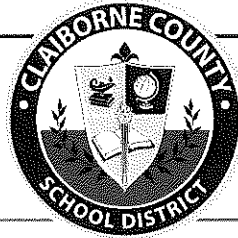

The District Food Safety plan did not contain all of the required elements as required by federal regulations.

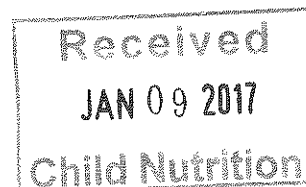
Corrective Action:
