Dear Mr. McKay:

The State Agency completed an Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast Program (SBP) and Afterschool Care Program (ASCP) during the week of November 13, 2017. The regulations governing the Administrative Review (7CFR 210.18) reference two Critical Areas of performance: Performance Standard 1 and Performance Standard 2, as well as several General Areas of Review. While findings were identified, there were no findings related to the two performance standards. The findings are described below.

General Program Compliance

- School Food Authority (SFA) on-site Monitoring documentation was not available for review for school year 16-17 [Regulation 7 CFR 210.8].
- Smart Snacks in school store did not meet regulatory requirements of products sold to students. The product determined not to meet requirements after data was entered into the Smart Snacks calculator was potato skins.

Meal Pattern & Nutritional Quality

- Dietary Specifications and Nutrition Analysis requirements were not met [Regulation 7 CFR 210.10(f)]. The lunch menu was not planned based on the age/grade group.

We provided technical assistance (TA) in several areas to the Child Nutrition Director. These comments are located in the Mississippi Application and Reimbursement System (MARS), in the comments section of the On-site Assessment Tool. These comments are provided for the improvement of the program operations.

A corrective action response to the findings of this review is due by December 27, 2017.

Your corrective action response must be entered in MARS by the Child Nutrition Director.
