The State Agency completed an Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) during the week of April 16, 2018. The regulations governing the Administrative Review (7CFR 210.18) reference two Critical Areas of Performance: Performance Standard 1 and Performance Standard 2, as well as, several General Areas of Review. No findings were identified for this review.
