Dear Dr. Benigno:

The State Agency completed an Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), and School Breakfast Program (SBP) during the week of November 13, 2017. The regulations governing the Administrative Review (7CFR 210.18) reference two Critical Areas of Performance: Performance Standard 1 and Performance Standard 2, as well as several General Areas of Review. The findings are described below:

Meal Pattern and Nutritional Quality

The Offer versus Serve (OVS) requirements were not met; observed several students without a reimbursable tray. The students must select at least 1/2 cup of either the fruit or vegetable component to meet the OVS Provision (7 CFR 210.10 (e)).

We provided technical assistance (TA) in several areas to the Child Nutrition Director. These comments are located in the Mississippi Application and Reimbursement System (MARS), in the comments section of the On-site Assessment Tool. These comments are provided for the improvement of the program operations.

A corrective action response to the findings of this review is due by January 15, 2018.

Your corrective action response must be entered in MARS by the Child Nutrition Director.
