Dear Dr. Hale:

The State Agency completed an Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast Program (SBP) and Afterschool Care Program (ASCP) during the week of February 26, 2018. The regulations governing the Administrative Review (7 CFR 210.18) reference two Critical Areas of performance: Performance Standard 1 and Performance Standard 2, as well as several General Areas of Review. The following finding(s) were identified:

Offer versus Serve (Performance Standard 2)

 High school students at H.W. Byers School were required to get 5 items on their tray for lunch. OVS was not practiced despite being listed on the NSLP application for all levels. OVS is mandatory on the high school level [Regulation 7 CFR 210.10].

Technical assistance (TA) was provided in several areas for the improvement of the program operations to the Child Nutrition Director. The comments are located in the Mississippi Application and Reimbursement System (MARS), in the comments section of the On-site Assessment Tool.

A corrective action response is due by June 2, 2018 and must be entered into MARS by the Child Nutrition Director.
