The State Agency (SA) completed an Administrative Review (AR) of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) during the week of April 1, 2019. The regulations governing the Administrative Review (7 CFR 210.18) require the SA to review two Critical Areas of performance: Performance Standard 1 (Meal Access and Reimbursement) and Performance Standard 2 (Meal Pattern and Nutritional Quality). The Review additionally covers several General Areas of Review. The SA is pleased to report **that no findings were identified** over the course of the Review. We are closing the district's file for this review period.

In addition to conducting the AR, one of the functions of the SA is to provide Technical Assistance (TA). During the course of the review, the SA Reviewer provided TA in several areas to the Child Nutition Director (CND). TA is documented in MARS, specifically in the "Technical Assistance" section of the "Compliance" Module. TA is provided for the improvement of the program operations and is not considered a finding.

The SA would like to commend Ms. Brooke Dew, as well as all Child Nutrition staff for the excellent job they do in planning and providing meals for the children of the Enterprise School District. Ms. Dew does an excellent job with the Child Nutrition Program and her dedication is greatly appreciated.
