Dear Mr. Ellzey:

The State Agency completed an Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) during the week of November 26, 2018. The regulations governing the Administrative Review (7 CFR 210.18) reference two Critical Areas of performance: Performance Standard 1 and Performance Standard 2, as well as several General Areas of Review. Over the course of the review, the State Agency identified **one finding** across two different age groups related to Performance Standard 2 which is described below.

**Meal Pattern and Nutritional Quality (Performance Standard 2)**

- The K-8 Lunch Nutritional Analysis weekly calorie requirement was over by one calorie during the review week (7 CFR 210.10 (f)).
- The 9-12 Lunch Nutritional Analysis weekly calorie requirement was under by three calories during the review week (7 CFR 210.10 (f)).

Over the course of the review, we provided Technical Assistance (TA) in several areas to the Child Nutrition Director. These comments are located in the Mississippi Application and Reimbursement System (MARS), specifically, in the comments section of the On-site Assessment Tool. TA is provided for the improvement of program operations, however we may monitor continued progress in these areas.

Your corrective action response to all findings must be entered in MARS by the Child Nutrition Director by **January 11, 2019**.
