Dear Dr. Brantley:

The State Agency completed an Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) during the week of November 26, 2018. The regulations governing the Administrative Review [7 CFR 210.18] reference two Critical Areas of Performance: Performance Standard 1 and Performance Standard 2, as well as several General Areas of Review. The findings are described below:

Performance Standard 1

• One application was approved free on the initial determination by the School Food Authority. Further review by the State Agency indicates the eligibility category should be reduced [7 CFR 245.6].

The District must submit documentation indicating that it plans to institute a second party check of the meal application process along with a copy of the letter to the household showing the change in benefit status.

General Program Compliance

• The tracker tool that is utilized by the District for Professional Development was missing the following required data: 1. Date hired; 2. Title/Position; 3. Professional Standards Category; and 4. Employment Status [7 CFR 210.30].

The District must submit documentation indicating that it has made all the required corrections to the tracker tool and provide a copy of the revised tracker tool to the State Agency.

• Food in the frozen storage area of the review site Neshoba Central Elementary School was not stored six inches above the floor in accordance to the State of Mississippi Health Code [7 CFR 210.13].

The District must submit documentation indicating that it has corrected the issue at the site with the necessary equipment to meet the State Health Code.

We provided Technical Assistance (TA) in several areas to the Child Nutrition Director. These comments are located in the Mississippi Application and Reimbursement System (MARS), in the comments section of the On-site Assessment Tool. These comments are provided for the improvement of the program operations.

A corrective action response to the findings of this review is due by **January 18, 2019**. Your corrective action response must be entered in MARS by the Child Nutrition Director.
