Dear Dr. Edwards:

The State Agency completed an Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast Program (SBP) during the week of November 27, 2017. The regulations governing the Administrative Review (7CFR 210.18) reference two Critical Areas of Performance: Performance Standard 1 and Performance Standard 2, as well as several General Areas of Review. While findings were identified, there were no findings related to the two performance standards. The findings are described below:

General Program Compliance

- The written food safety plan for the district is missing all the required elements.
- Professional Standards are not being tracked for all the Child Nutrition staff in the district as required.


We provided technical assistance (TA) in several areas to the Child Nutrition Director.
